

Dar-ul-Madinah Uniform Policy

It is mandatory for students to wear uniform while at Dar-ul-Madinah. Parents / guardians are requested to send their Madani children in proper, neat and clean uniform daily. The description of uniform is as follows:

For boys:

1. It is obligatory to wear white **Kurta** (kali dar) with two front pockets, up to half of the shin in length, hand-span wide sleeves; **shalwar** above the ankles and a bright green-colored **turban** on head.
2. Hair should be neat, clean and properly done.
3. Only plain black socks are allowed.
4. Shoes should be plain, black and polished. (without any design)
5. Only V-neck, dark brown sweaters are allowed in winter. (Make sure the brown color should not be like black)

For girls:

1. Uniform for girls is plain white **shalwar kameez**. (Fancy, Embroidery & fashionable shalwar kameez are not allowed)
2. Only dark brown sweaters (cardigans) are allowed in winter. (Make sure the brown color should not be like black)
3. Students of class V or higher (12 years or older) should wear plain and loose-fitting black abaya with plain black Dupatta / black scarf. They should also wear black gloves.
4. All girls must wear green scarf in the school premises.
5. Hair should completely be covered with the scarf.
6. Only plain black socks are allowed.
7. Shoes should be plain, black, polished & flat. (without any design)
8. It is not allowed to wear any kind of makeup, accessories and jewellery (earrings, rings, bangles, etc.)
