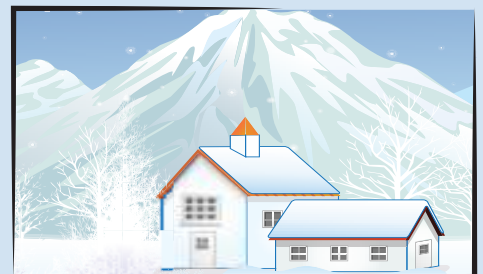

Winter Season – Spring for True Muslims

All the seasons are from Allah. Either it is summer, winter, autumn or spring, each season has its own blessings. Among the four seasons, winter has its own charm. Our ancestors used to be very happy when winter season came. They would consider this season a reason for an increase in their worship. Winter season brings with it a lot of presents.



Dry fruits – due to warm effects – are abundantly used in this season. In short, we get many benefits from this season. However, in case of taking no safety measures, especially children take the negative effects of this season and fall ill. Some safety measures are mentioned below in this regard.

In order to keep your children safe in winter season:

- Make them wear warm clothes, i.e. jacket/sweater, thick socks and shoes at home and especially while sending them to school.
- Give them boiled eggs, warm milk / tea for breakfast.
- Give them seasonal fruits, vegetables and dry fruits as per your financial ability.
- Give them fish from time to time. (Remember! Give them these foods as per the health condition of your children.)
- Use gas or electrical heater as per the need at home. (Turn off the heater before sleeping.)
- In case of extreme cold weather, make the children wear some warm clothes under the school uniform.
- Give them hand gloves while sending them to school.
- If you travel on motorbike, completely cover the child.
- If travel by car or van, close the glass window.
- Use normal water to drink and luke-warm water for Wudu and bath.
- Keep the children from drinking cold water and playing in it.
- Keep them from staying without barefooted and bareheaded.
- Sit your children in sunlight for some time.
- To protect their skin, lips and heels, use lotion, etc.
