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Parenting

Common Mistakes in Children's Upbringing

Every person who is blessed with the role of a mother or father desires to succeed in raising their children well. However, often unknowingly, parents make certain mistakes that negatively impact their children, and over time, these mistakes can prove harmful. Below are some important points in this regard. Read them yourself and share with others as well:

- When children seem a little troubled, don't rush immediately to help them. Instead, give them the opportunity to face challenges themselves so they can develop the ability to handle difficulties.
- Constantly comparing children with their friends, relatives, or siblings can damage their self-confidence, so avoid this practice.
- Do not give the same reactions to every kind of performance or task.
- Share your own experiences and even small past mistakes with your children so they can avoid repeating them.
- A child being intelligent does not mean they can always distinguish between right and wrong. Therefore, instead of relying solely on intelligence, keep children under your observation.





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- Whatever you instruct your children to do, practice it yourself as well. If your words and actions contradict each other, your advice will not impact them.
- Do not always be overly lenient nor excessively strict. Maintain a balance by showing gentleness at times and firmness when required.
- Do not give children unlimited freedom, as it may cause them to resist rules and discipline in the future. At the same time, do not impose extreme restrictions, as this may push them toward rebellion.
- Deal with children like a consultant, not like a boss.
- Avoid punishing children in front of others, as it can harm their self-confidence and create negative emotions in them.
- Some parents, by being overly protective, make their children too delicate in nature. Avoid this, because children must live in society, and if they are overly sensitive, they won't be able to face hardships with courage.
- Instead of overloading children with an unbalanced timetable that makes them robotic, set a suitable schedule that includes studies along with other healthy activities.
- Refrain from unethical or inappropriate conversation, especially in front of children.
- When parents lie on the phone in front of their children, or when a visitor comes and the father says, "Tell them I'm not home," it is, in fact, a form of teaching children how to lie.

By avoiding these mistakes and adopting a balanced approach, parents can raise children who are confident, disciplined, and well-prepared to face life's challenges with strength and wisdom.

At Dar-ul-Madinah Nepal, a Fruit and Vegetable Day was organised to help students identify different fruits and vegetables and learn about their benefits.

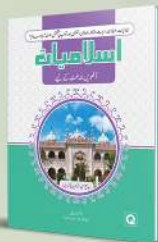
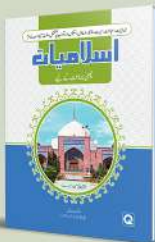
