Wise Ways to Guide Children in Avoiding Undesirable Actions

Intelligent and active children often become the apple of the eye at home. While their mischief can delight hearts and bring smiles to faces, it can sometimes cause significant problems. Out of fear, some parents impose excessive restrictions on every action of their children, scolding or reprimanding them constantly. This can lead to stubbornness and various psychological issues in children. At such times, parents should act with wisdom and explain things patiently. This article offers some wise and effective ways to guide children.



1 | Provide a substitute

When a child does something you do not like or that is inappropriate for them, do not immediately say: "Don't do it!" Instead, redirect their attention to another activity.

For example, if a child starts colouring on the wall with crayons, explain: "If you colour on paper, it will look beautiful. Come, let's colour on paper together!" You can also keep colouring books at home and give them to the child at that moment. This approach also helps build the child's confidence.



2 | Explain the Consequences

If a child does not listen, explain the consequences of the action logically. For example, "If you do not wash your hands before eating, you may get sick and have to take bitter medicine or follow dietary restrictions." Teach children to think logically about cause and effect.



3 | Explain with Love and Kindness

Not every lesson should be delivered harshly. Approach children gently—sometimes placing a hand on their shoulder, holding their hand softly, hugging them, or kissing their forehead while speaking calmly.

For instance, if a child is teasing another and enjoying it, call them over, hold them gently, tickle slightly, and explain in a soft voice how to play kindly with others.



4 | Don't React Immediately

If a child does something wrong or breaks something at home, do not get angry immediately. Wait for 5-10 seconds, take two or three deep breaths, observe the child's expression carefully, then respond gently. This ensures your reaction has a positive effect and prevents the situation from escalating.



5 | Criticize the Action, Not the Child

Correct the child's behaviour, but never attack their personality. For example, instead of saying, "You are very rude!" say: "Shouting is not something good children do. Good children speak gently." This helps the child understand their mistake and accept correction.



6 | Explain by Telling a Story or Giving an Example

Repeatedly giving advice can also make children irritable. They may listen to the advice, but they do not take steps to act upon it. Therefore, teach them through stories as well. For example: Rehan was a very good child. Once, while playing, he said something to his friends and everyone agreed with him. He felt very happy about this. After that, he

began insisting on having his own way in everything and would say, "Only what I say is right; you all must agree with me." Gradually, all his friends stopped playing with him, and he was left alone. Eventually, he apologized to all his friends. They forgave him, and everyone started playing together again.

At the end, also ask the children: What did we learn from this story? In this way, children become immediately attentive, take interest in learning, and draw conclusions on their own.



7 | Let the Child Make a Choice

Offer two good options and let the child choose. For example, present two toys and ask which one they prefer. Once the child chooses, ask why they made that choice. This helps develop decision-making skills and a sense of responsibility.



8 | Spiritual and Moral Tarbiyah

Explain to children that Allah is watching us and all our actions, and that He hears everything we say. Therefore, they should stay away from bad deeds. Ask them: would you like Allah to be displeased with you?

Similarly, sometimes explain it this way: the beloved Prophet of Allah ﷺ loved every good thing, so we should do good deeds. This helps develop fear of

Allah and love for the Messenger in the hearts of children. This nurtures God-consciousness and love for the Prophet in their hearts.

9 | Don't Forget to Pray

As mentioned in Hadith: "Supplication is the weapon of a believer" (Mustad Abu Y'ala, 2/201, Hadith: 1806).

Pray daily for your children: "O Allah, make my children good and righteous, remove their bad habits, help them live cooperatively, and make them regular in Salah." Just as Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام prayed for his offspring:

﴿رَبِّ اجْعَلْنِي مُقِيمَ الصَّلَاةِ وَمِنْ ذُرِّيَّتِي﴾
