الحمد لله رب العالمين! The academic year **2025-26** of Dar-ul-Madinah concluded successfully. During this year, we introduced several positive changes that became a source of progress and achievement. As a result, not only did the academic standards of our students improve, but the institutional system also became stronger. ان شاء الله, we will continue striving to enhance our system further in the coming academic year.

The year 2025 proved to be an important milestone for Dar-ul-Madinah. Students of classes 9 and 10 achieved an overall success rate of **93.4%** across Sindh and Punjab, while **57%** of students secured **A+ and A grades**. A particularly encouraging highlight was that **59 students** of class 9 (SSC-I) scored above **90% marks**. Especially notable was the outstanding performance of **Bint-e-Iftikhar Khan** from **Faisalabad Campus**, who secured **99.24% marks**.

In addition, our **884 students** performed remarkably in the **Pakistan Maths Challenge 2025**. Among them, **128 students** won **Gold Medals**, **176** won **Silver Medals**, and **111** won **Bronze Medals**. Dar-ul-Madinah also secured **three first positions nationwide** in classes 3, 6, and 7. These accomplishments clearly demonstrate that Dar-ul-Madinah is not only providing quality education but is also excelling in co-curricular activities.

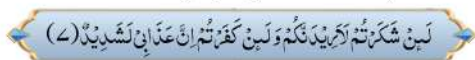
Make your children grateful

Gratitude is a very important and fundamental quality. It is a virtue that brings peace, contentment, and happiness into a person's heart. A grateful person always maintains a positive mindset and remains protected from jealousy, greed, and disappointment.

Therefore, it is an important responsibility of parents to teach their children the habit of gratitude from an early age so that they may grow into the best members of society. To develop gratitude in children, explain to them its importance and benefits.

The importance and benefits of gratitude

The importance of gratitude has been highlighted in the Holy Quran: Allah Almighty says in the Quran,

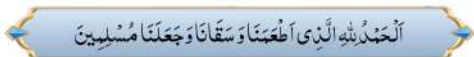
"If you thank Me, then I shall most definitely grant you more, and if you are ungrateful, (then) indeed my punishment is severe."

This verse teaches us that gratitude becomes a means of increasing blessings. It is extremely important to instill in children the understanding that gratitude leads to an increase in blessings, while ingratitude is disliked by Allah Almighty.

Ways to make children grateful

- To develop the habit of gratitude in your children, teach them that whenever they receive any blessing, they should thank Allah Almighty. Sayyiduna Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه narrated that whenever the Noble Prophet صلی الله علیه و آله وسلم received glad tidings, he would perform the prostration of gratitude. (Ibn Majah, Vol. 2, p. 163, Hadith: 1394)
- Teach children to thank Allah whenever they eat or drink. The Beloved Prophet صلی الله علیه و آله وسلم said: "Allah Almighty loves that a person thanks Him for every morsel and every sip." (Muslim, p. 1122, Hadith: 6932)

- For very young children whom parents feed by hand, encourage them to say “الحمد لله” after each bite. Once they say it, give them the next bite. **الحمد لله**, within a few days the child will become accustomed to expressing gratitude with every morsel.
- When children finish eating, encourage them to say “الحمد لله” and recite the supplication after meals. Sayyiduna Abu Ayyub Ansari رضي الله عنه narrated that the Prophet صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم, after finishing food, would recite:



Translation: All praise is for Allah, who fed us, gave us drink, and made us Muslims.

- Children often compare themselves with others around them who appear to have more attractive lifestyles. As a result, the blessings in their own lives may seem less valuable to them. This can later lead to jealousy, disappointment, depression, and ingratitude. Parents should teach children that when comparing blessings, they should look at those who have less than them, not those who have more. The Prophet صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم said: “When one of you wishes to recognise the value of Allah’s blessings, he should look at those who have less, not those who have more.” (Al-Zuhd by Ibn al-Mubarak, p. 502, Hadith: 1433)
- Train children to remember Allah’s blessings every night before sleeping and thank Him for them.
- Help children recognize blessings. Make them realise daily how valuable their health, home, parents, education, and peace are. Explain to them that many people in the world are deprived of these blessings.
- To build the habit of gratitude, it is also important to tell children about the harms of ingratitude.

Harms of Ingratitude

- Ingratitude creates jealousy in a person, and jealousy destroys good deeds. The Noble Prophet صلی اللہ علیہ وسلم said: Jealousy consumes good deeds just as fire consumes wood. (Ibn Majah, Vol. 4, p. 361, Hadith: 4903)
- Ingratitude causes Allah’s blessings to be taken away and keeps a person trapped in disappointment and dissatisfaction, whereas gratitude protects blessings. Sayyiduna Umar bin Abdul Aziz رحمۃ اللہ علیہ said, “Preserve the blessings of Allah through gratitude.” (Hilyat al-Awliya,

Vol. 5, p. 374, No. 323)

Sayyiduna Imam Hasan Basri رحمه الله عليه said that it has reached him that when Allah grants blessings to a people, He asks gratitude from them. If they are grateful, He is all-powerful to give them more, and if they are ungrateful, He is also all-powerful to punish them. He can replace His blessings with punishment. (Shur'ab al-Iman, Vol. 4, p. 127, Hadith: 4536)

O Allah! Make us and our children among those who are grateful.
