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Parenting

Connect children with the Qur'an

How to connect children with the Qur'an? This question arises in the minds of parents who have an Islamic tendency. It is important to remember that developing a child's attachment to the Qur'an is not something that happens in a single day. Rather, it requires consistent effort, wisdom, and practical nurturing. Below are some valuable suggestions that parents can follow to strengthen their children's relationship with the Qur'an.

Instil Love for the Qur'an

The first step in connecting children with the Qur'an is to help them realise that it is the Book of Allah, and loving it is an essential part of faith. Teach your children that Allah grants the opportunity to recite, teach, understand, and explain the Qur'an to those whom He loves. Tell them that the best among people are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it to others. (Sahih al-Bukhari, Hadith: 5027). Explain to children that the Qur'an is the great book that will intercede on behalf of those who learn it, teach it, and act upon it, and will lead them to Paradise. (Tarikh Ibn Asakir; Al-Mu'jam al-Kabir, Hadith 10450). Also let them know that teaching even a single verse of the Qur'an to someone is a form of Sadaqah Jariyah (ongoing charity) that continues to earn rewards. (Jam' al-Jawami', Hadith 22456). By explaining the importance of the Qur'an to children in this way, ان شاء الله, they will develop a love for the Qur'an in their hearts, and their bond with it will grow even stronger.

Pray for Your Children

Prayer (Dua) is a powerful means to connect children with the Quran. Parents should sincerely pray before Allah to grant our children the love of the Holy Quran in their hearts, its understanding, and the ability to act upon it.

Create an Environment of Quran Recitation

To connect children with the Quran, it is essential to create an environment in the home for reciting and listening to the Quran. For this purpose, some time should be dedicated daily to reciting the Quran at home. Before sleeping, the 3 Quls or Surah Al-Mulk should be recited and listened to. ان شاء الله, the children will remain connected to the Quran.

Make Arrangements for Memorising Short Surahs

Another way to connect children with the Quran is to make arrangements for them to memorise short Surahs. First and foremost, they should be taught to memorise the 3 Quls, Surah Al-Asr, Surah Al-Kawthar, Surah Quraysh, and other similar Surahs.

Narrate Quranic Stories

Children love listening to stories, so narrating Quranic stories will also prove highly helpful in connecting them with the Quran. Maktabat-ul-Madina's book "Ajaib-ul-Quran ma Gharaib-ul-Quran" (Wonders of the Quran with Unique Traits of the Quran) will be resourceful in this regard. Additionally, the Madani Channel series "Ek Qissa Hai Quran Se" (A Story from the Quran) is also very beneficial.

Play Recitations of Melodious Quran Reciters (Qurra)

To help children develop a strong connection with the Qur'an, let them listen to the recitation of skilled Qaris who recite the Qur'an melodiously while observing the rules of Tajweed. ان شاء الله, this will inspire them to read the Qur'an and encourage them to recite it beautifully and correctly.

Organise Qur'an Competitions

One of the most effective ways to develop children's love for the Qur'an and increase their interest in it is by organising Qur'an competitions. Such competitions inspire children to recite the Qur'an correctly

with proper Tajweed and motivate them to practise its teachings in their daily lives. Parents should ensure that these competitions are enjoyable and encouraging activities rather than stressful tests, so that children remain positively connected with the Qur'an.

Examples of Qur'an Competitions

- Hold a Qur'an recitation competition in which children recite different Surahs in a beautiful voice while observing proper Tajweed.
- Organise a memorisation competition in which children memorise short Surahs, **Qur'anic supplications**, or selected verses. For example: **Surah Al-Asr, Surah Al-Fil, Surah Al-Kawthar, Surah Al-Ikhlās, Surah Al-Falaq, Surah An-Nas, and Ayat al-Kursi.**
- Arrange a **Qur'anic Character Competition**, where children share practical examples of the noble qualities taught in the Qur'an, such as **truthfulness, establishing Salah, treating parents with kindness**, and other virtuous manners.
- Conduct a **Qur'an Storytelling Competition**, where children narrate Qur'anic stories in their own words, such as the story of Prophets Musa and Khidr عَلَيْهِمَا السَّلَام, Prophet Ibrahim's عَلَيْهِ السَّلَام trust in Allah, or the faith of the 'People of the Cave' (أَصْحَابُ الْكَهْف).

Children who perform well should be praised and encouraged. If possible, reward them with a small gift. This positive reinforcement will strengthen their attachment to the Qur'an even further.

Encourage Participation in Qur'an Gatherings

Qur'an gatherings, such as **Dars-e-Qur'an** (Qur'an lessons) and **Khatm-e-Qur'an** programmes, provide an excellent opportunity to strengthen children's relationship with the Qur'an. Parents should encourage mature children to attend these gatherings with them.

Participating in such gatherings not only nurtures love for the Qur'an in children's hearts but also allows them to benefit from the blessings of a righteous environment. As a result, they develop greater respect, humility, and a stronger attachment to their faith.

Tarbiyah & Professional Development Sessions

To promote Islamic values, enhance professional competencies, and further strengthen institutional performance, the Education Council of Dawat-e-Islami organised a two-day **Tarbiyah & Professional Development Sessions** from **12-13 June 2026** at **Faizan-e-Madinah, Karachi**. Staff members from Dar-ul-Madinah International Islamic School System, Dar-ul-Madinah Cambridge, and Faizan Islamic School System from across Pakistan participated in the sessions.

The first session was delivered by **Mufti Muhammad Kafeel Raza Madani**, who spoke on the topic **"Challenges of Modern Curriculum from Shariah Prospective and their Solutions for Teachers."** He provided comprehensive guidance and explained how teachers can nurture students' minds in accordance with Islamic beliefs and values.

The principals and coordinators also had the opportunity to exchange experiences, learn from best practices, and receive guidance on effective strategies for further improving educational standards.





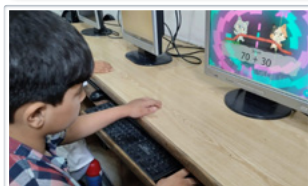
Summer Camp 2026

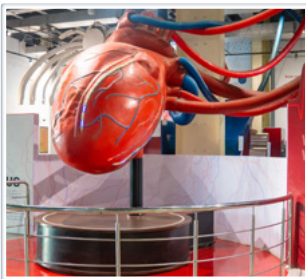

Traffic Rules Awareness

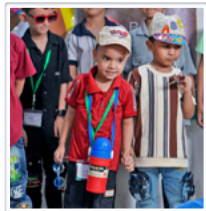

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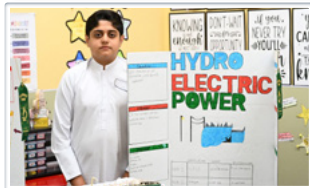
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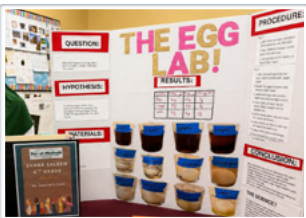
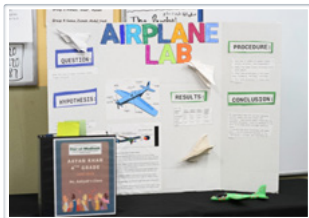
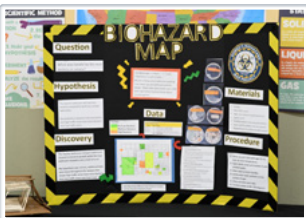
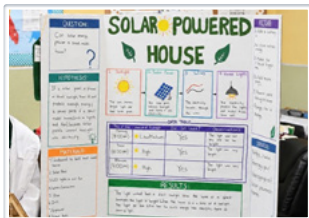
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Science Day 2026 Dar-ul-Madinah USA
